Essays must be typewritten, double-spaced, and work must be an original essay by the student. Any plagiarized work will be disqualified. (Plagiarism is the submission of any portion of the essay that is not the student's own work).

Essays will be judged on the following listed in order of importance:

- 1. Overall quality
- 2. Organization
- 3. Grammar and spelling

For judging purposes, each paper is assigned a number. No judge will know the name of the student who has written this essay. The Angelo family will participate in judging of the essay submissions. The Development Office will keep this information confidential. If you include your name, parents' names, or any family members' names in any areas of the essay, your paper will be disqualified.
