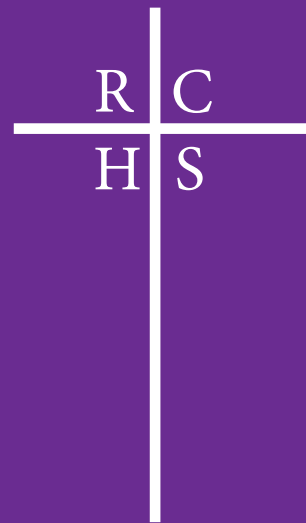

It is great to report on all the wonderful things that have happened at Routt Catholic High School during the 2014-2015 school year. We hired Mr. Paul Herring, (Math) and Mrs. Betsy Kennedy (General Studies) to tutor students during the day and after school. Mrs. Patricia Boldt was hired to teach Science classes. Dana Bergschneider was hired to assist as administrative assistant in the front office. Mr. Roscetti completed his first year as Principal/Superintendent, and doing a great job of moving our school forward.

Test scores for the 2015 seniors continue to be above state average; with math scores not where we would like them, we are anticipating improvement over the next years with our tutor in place. Enrollment has increased from 117 to 123 students.

As the 2014-15 school year ends the 2015-16 academic year reaches full speed. Rount Catholic High School begins the first year of our new 5-year Long Range Plan. Thanks to the many who participated in the development of this plan which was funded by the Tracy Family Foundation of Mt. Sterling. Planning began in January, 2015 and a guide was completed in June. We will focus on the four Pillars of Excellence that will allow us to grow with and for our students.

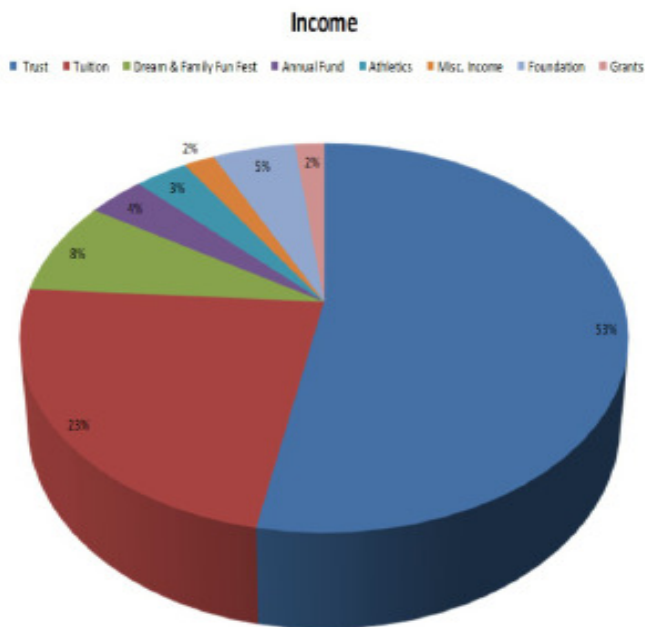

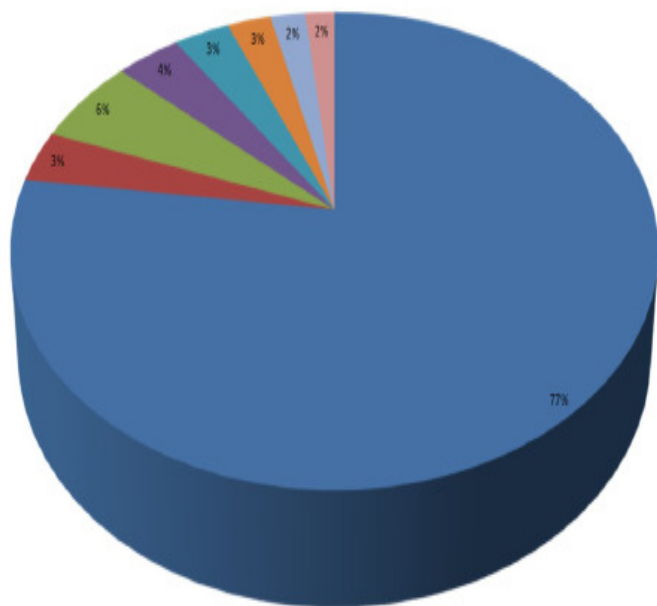

Enrollment and Tuition

Rouff Catholic High School enrollment for 2014-15 school year ended with 115 students in grades 9 - 12. Rouff admits students of any race, nationality and religion without discrimination with respect to ability or achievement levels, believing that all have a right to a Christian education. Out-of-parish students make up 6% of the student body and students of other faiths total 29%. Five percent of Rouff students are eligible for a free or reduced lunch.

The Board again voted not to increase tuition for the sixth year in a row, keeping tuition at \$3,700 with \$200 fees for all families. Families can also receive a waiver of half of the fees as an incentive for early enrollment. The Rouff Board is committed to holding tuition at a level our families can manage, especially in difficult economic times.

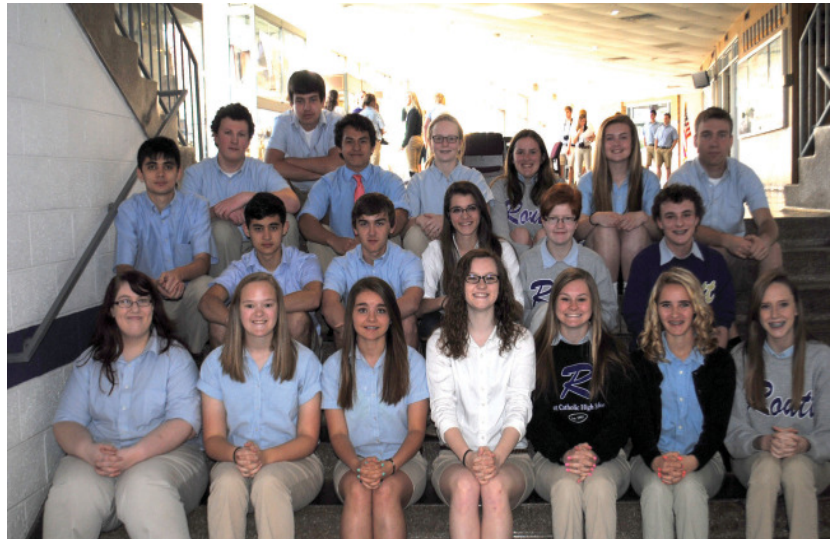

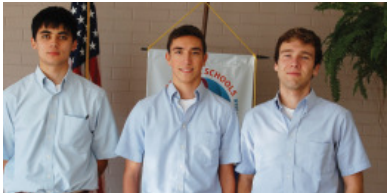

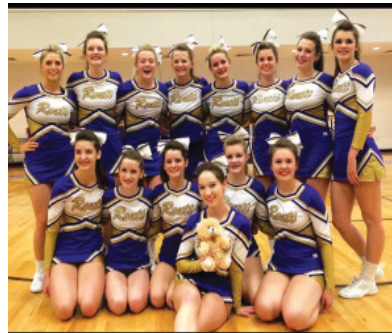

Routt High School Education Foundation

The Routt High School Education Foundation, Inc. was formed in May of 1990 by Sr. Philip Neri Crawford and the members of the Routt High School Alumni Association. They felt it important to create a legal entity controlled locally with the purpose of receiving contributions for the benefit of Routt.
